Description of Event

West Glos & Dean Forest MCC will hold the Boxing Day Trial. The trial will be open to affiliated members of an ACU club. The event will be run under the National Sporting Code, the Standing Trials Regulations of the ACU, the following supplementary regulations and any final instructions that may be issued.

- This event is a Non Stop Trial, Re. TSR22B.
- The event will consist of the main adult trial and a concurrent 'conducted' trial for C,D and E class riders and beginners.
- Disciplinary Action - Riders are reminded that any abusive or threatening behaviour towards officials, including harassment of observers, is in breach of NSC 11.01.7. This also applies to any member of the rider's entourage, including parents and guardians of youth riders.
- Competitors are reminded that; all combustion engine machines, and Electric machines used by Youth competitors must be fitted with an operational lanyard operated cut out device, Re TSR8.
